

Required information/documents for players from abroad aged 10 and over

The following must be noted for international club transfers of players aged 10 and over and for players who do not have the German citizenship and who apply for a playing right as a first request in Germany. This does not apply to players under 10 years of age, for whom the playing right can be applied for without additional documents:

The application for a playing right is possible either online or by post.

Basic information (must always be entered on the application)

- For first request
 - Full name of the player
 - Date of birth/Place of birth/State of residence
 - Country of last residence
- For international transfers
 - Full name of the player
 - Date of birth/Place of birth/State of residence
 - Last club abroad, exact club name
 - Last FIFA association

- Additional documents required for players over 18 years of age
 - Identity document (incl. photo)

- Additional documents required for players between 10-17 years of age
 - Identity document (incl. photo)
 - Official registration confirmation from the residents' registration office for the player's family

Please note: For exchange and guest students, the application is only possible by post. The following documents are required:

- Original application for the playing right with signature of the player and a host parent
- Copy of passport/identity card of the player
- Copy of passport/identity card of the parents
- Documentation of the exchange programme (purpose, duration with start and end of the exchange programme; issued by the organiser of the programme).
- Proof of accommodation (official registration confirmation from the registration office for the player)
